1. Recent Activity

The Chair was pleased to summarize the recent activity of EPC over the year (please note the below is not necessarily in chronological order)

- 1.1 The Bus Shelter had been repainted and assorted repairs to guttering, roof and shelter light undertaken and the water butt replaced
- 1.2 A defibrillator training session was organized at the Golden Pheasant was very well attended by the village and good feedback was received.
- 1.3 Planters for the green were acquired (C&P grant funded) and subsequently installed and planted up with an assortment of perennials
- 1.4 Following the installation of white gates at the entrances to the village carrying speed limit signs EPC had managed to get the old speed limit signs removed as they were very close to new gates and were therefore superfluous
- 1.5 A Remembrance Day event was organized on the village green
- 1.6 Some 500 bulbs were planted in and around the village following their donation by Landyke Trust

2. Ongoing and Forthcoming Activity

- 2.1 It was noted some time ago that the village sign on the green had been slowly deteriorating and following a donation of a piece of Oak a new sign is in the process of being designed and then carved (by a village inhabitant). A grant has been agreed to assist with the funding thereof.
- 2.2 Numerous activities are planned during 2025 in which the various EPC members are assisting in various ways such as with the St Stephens 800 year celebration, the beer festival etc

The Chair and Vice Chair would sincerely like to thank all members of EPC for their contributions of time and effort over the last year and also numerous other villagers for their help with various projects and activities and events all of which are intended to help make the village of Etton a friendly place to live and socialize and also a place with a great community spirit.
